### **Pool Rules & Regulations**

The VRHOA pool facilities are for the exclusive use of homeowners and their guests. Any homeowner or any other person found in the facility during closed hours will be considered trespassing. If you see anyone in the facilities after hours, please call the Sheriff's Department at 255-1121.

### **Operating Hours**

Sunday through Thursday 8:00 AM to 10:00 PM

Friday & Saturday 8:00 AM to 11:00 PM

1. No lifeguard is on duty.
2. No child under age 14 is permitted in the pool without adult supervision. This is a state law.
3. All persons using the pool facilities do so at their own risk. The VRHOA is not responsible for any accident or injury to any person in the facility or for any lost, stolen or damaged articles.
4. Invited guests must be accompanied while in the facility by a VRHOA homeowner. The homeowner is responsible for their family and guests.
5. Pool safety equipment is to be used for life saving purposes only. If you notice missing or damaged equipment, please notify Crown Management at 799-1135.
6. The following is not allowed in or around the pool facilities:
  - Running
  - Glass containers
  - Pets
  - Audio devices or loud noise
  - Riding of skateboards or bicycles
  - Oversized pool toys
7. The VRHOA Board of Directors has the authority to restrict the use of the pool facilities to anyone found violating the pool rules and regulations.
8. Residents must limit the number of guests they bring to the pool so as to not interfere with other residents' use and enjoyment.

9. The pool area is not for private parties. Exceptions can be made, so if you want to have a party, please clear it in advance with the Board of Directors.
10. Absolutely no unlawful activity will be tolerated on any Association property. This includes underage consumption of alcohol, drug use, etc. Any such activity will be reported to the Sheriff.
11. If you smoke, use the ash tray (or bring one with you). Please do not crush cigarettes on the deck around the pool and spa.
12. Do not add anything to the water in the spa. Soap bubbles may be fun, but they destroy the chemical balance in the water. The entire recreation area is subject to being closed by the County if the proper water balances are not maintained.
13. Absolutely, positively do not bring anything whatsoever that is made of glass into the pool and spa area.
14. No guests are allowed in the pool area unless accompanied at all times by a resident (with a key).

There are some common sense rules that we must ask everyone to please abide by:

- Place trash in the receptacles provided.
- Use a towel on the lounge chairs when using suntan lotion or oil. Rinse off in the shower before going into the pool or spa.
- Close the gate all the way when you enter or leave. This keeps little ones from wandering out of the facility and prevents non-members from entering the facility.
- Straighten the lounge chairs when you leave.
